

Paolo Aglietti, MD

Dr. Aglietti graduated in 1967 from the University of Florence (Italy) with a degree in medicine. He performed his residency in orthopaedics and traumatology at the University of Florence from 1968 to 1970. He served two surgery clinical fellowships in hip and knee at the Hospital for Special Surgery in New York City from 1972-1974.

After obtaining his specialized skills in the U.S, Dr. Aglietti returned to Italy and served as an Assistant Professor of Orthopaedics and Traumatology at the University of Perugia from 1975-1978 and an Associate Professor of Orthopaedics and Traumatology at the University of Florence from 1979 to 1989. He was promoted to full professor in 1990. During this time, Dr. Aglietti also served as the orthopaedic and traumatology residency director. One of his greatest professional accomplishments is serving as the professor and chairman of the First Orthopaedic Clinic at the University of Florence. He was also a founding member of the Italian Society of Knee Surgery (ISKS) and the Italian Society of Arthroscopy (ISA), serving as ISA's president in 1982 and 1989. He has published more than 120 articles in journals around the world and was a co-editor of the book, *Surgery of the Knee*. He is currently serving as the president of the International Society of Knee Surgery and Arthroscopy (ISAKOS).
