The Sports Fellowship under director Michael D. Maloney is fully-integrated with the orthopaedic residency. The two sports fellows are exposed to a full spectrum of sports medicine through rotations including additional faculty members: Ilya Voloshin, MD; Brian Giordano, MD; Gregg Nicandri, MD; Sandeep Mannava, MD; and John Goldblatt, MD.

The one year program provides a broad experience in all aspects of the care of the athlete. Our team of sports surgeons will provide exposure and training with advanced operative experiences in arthroscopy of the knee, shoulder, elbow, and hip. Operative experience will also include open shoulder and hip reconstructive procedures. In addition, the fellowship provides the opportunity to participate in extensive inpatient and outpatient musculoskeletal clinical care, injury prevention programs, performance enhancement programs, on-field and training room experiences for athletes from high school, college and professional teams. Dedicated time is provided for participation in clinical and translational research.
