Our fellowship is a one-year program that offers an in-depth experience in Orthopaedic Sports Medicine and is intended to provide fellows with the skills and knowledge to further their development. Throughout the year, fellows will be exposed to surgical and non-surgical treatment of various conditions ranging from student, collegiate and professional athletes to weekend warriors. The sports fellowship program offers advanced training in arthroscopy of the knee, hip, shoulder, and elbow. In addition to a high patient volume, including athletes from all levels of competition, a strong emphasis is placed on team coverage specifically high school, collegiate and professional sports.

The program further enhances the curriculum by offering monthly surgical skills labs in our state of the art facilities and dedicated time for clinical and translational research.
