ACGME Accredited 1-year
Fellowship Program**

University Hospitals Cleveland Medical Center is proud to announce ACGME accreditation for a new 1-year Orthopaedic Sports Medicine Fellowship. After completing the fellowship the physician will be eligible to participate in the Sports Medicine Certificate of Added Qualification (CAQ). The fellow in the UH Sports program will participate in the care of professional athletes at the NFL level, collegiate athletics, local high schools, and endurance athlete events. The program offers a high volume of surgical and clinical exposure consisting of knee arthroscopy and multi-ligament reconstruction, shoulder arthroscopy and reconstruction, hip arthroscopy, cartilage restoration and elbow arthroscopy. Additional exposure to sports related foot and ankle procedures, shoulder arthroplasty, and ultrasound guided injections has been incorporated for an incredibly well-rounded experience. The program's academic affiliate is Case Western Reserve University (CWRU), and a mature research program is in place.

The program is accredited to accept a fellow applicant to begin August 2017. Residents may also apply now for a position to begin August 2018.
