



Wake Forest Baptist Health Orthopaedic Sports Medicine Fellowship

This fellowship is designed to provide a complete experience in orthopaedic sports medicine, including: D-1 ACC and D-II collegiate athletic coverage experience; high volume and complex sports operative experience highlighting shoulder (including shoulder arthroplasty), knee and hip arthroscopy and cartilage and ligament reconstructive surgery; and a thorough experience in clinical care with dedicated sports faculty. The program offers a unique educational experience in the area of longitudinal patient care. Participation in faculty and training room clinics allows the fellow the opportunity to follow patients from the time of initial diagnosis through the course of treatment (including operative and post-operative care) during their fellowship year. In addition to our main campus, other locations include Wake Forest Baptist Health - Davie Medical Center, a new state-of-the-art hospital opened in 2013, and D-1 Sports - Winston-Salem, where sports medicine is partnered with athletic training. The Sports Medicine Fellowship offers a well-structured conference schedule and includes multi-disciplinary conferences with musculoskeletal radiology and primary care sports medicine. In addition, protected research time is provided and our research laboratory offers support for clinical and basic science research. A scholarly report is required to be prepared in a publishable format by the completion of the fellowship.
